Movement + Operation

Topic	Instruction
Movement	Hand-wound mechanical movement with small-seconds display.
Winding	Wind the crown by hand until gentle resistance is felt. Do not force the crown after resistance increases.

Setting the Time	Pull the crown to the time-setting position, rotate to the correct time, then push the crown fully back in.
Routine	For best performance, wind the watch at approximately the same time each day.

Care Instructions

- Avoid harsh chemicals, solvents, perfumes, and cleaning agents near the case, crystal, strap, and gaskets.
- Keep the watch away from strong magnetic fields, severe shock, and prolonged extreme temperatures.
- Wipe the case and crystal with a soft dry microfiber cloth after wear.
- Leather and suede straps should be kept as dry as possible; allow them to air dry naturally if damp.
- Rubber and stainless bracelets may be wiped down after sweat or water exposure, then dried thoroughly.
- Water resistance is not permanent and can be affected by impact, age, gasket wear, and crown position.
- Never operate the crown, chronograph pushers, or calendar correctors while the watch is wet or underwater.

Water-Resistance Notes

Listed water resistance: 3 ATM. Water resistance ratings describe controlled test conditions, not a permanent guarantee against water entry. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in or screwed down, if applicable, before exposure to moisture.
