Movement + Operation

Topic	Instruction
Movement	ST1655 automatic multi-function movement with calendar-style displays and 24-hour/day-night indication depending on configuration.
Starting/Winding	Wind the crown clockwise approximately 15 to 25 turns before wearing. Normal wrist motion helps maintain power.
Setting	Adjust time and calendar indications slowly and carefully. Never force the crown or correctors.

Calendar Caution	Avoid changing date, day, month, or calendar functions during the changeover window, generally 9:00 PM to 3:00 AM.
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Care Instructions

- Avoid harsh chemicals, solvents, perfumes, and cleaning agents near the case, crystal, strap, and gaskets.
- Keep the watch away from strong magnetic fields, severe shock, and prolonged extreme temperatures.
- Wipe the case and crystal with a soft dry microfiber cloth after wear.
- Leather and suede straps should be kept as dry as possible; allow them to air dry naturally if damp.
- Rubber and stainless bracelets may be wiped down after sweat or water exposure, then dried thoroughly.
- Water resistance is not permanent and can be affected by impact, age, gasket wear, and crown position.
- Never operate the crown, chronograph pushers, or calendar correctors while the watch is wet or underwater.

Water-Resistance Notes

Listed water resistance: 50M. Water resistance ratings describe controlled test conditions, not a permanent guarantee against water entry. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in or screwed down, if applicable, before exposure to moisture.
