## Owner Guide

## Movement + Operation

Topic	Instruction
Movement	Automatic three-hand movement with date, selected for reliability and daily wear.
Starting/Winding	Wind the crown clockwise approximately 15 to 25 turns before wearing. Normal wrist motion helps maintain power.
Setting the Date	Pull the crown to the first position and rotate gently until the correct date appears.

Setting the Time	Pull the crown to the second position, set the time, then push the crown fully back in.
Calendar Caution	Do not change the date during the changeover window, generally 9:00 PM to 3:00 AM.

## Care Instructions

- Avoid harsh chemicals, solvents, perfumes, and cleaning agents near the case, crystal, strap, and gaskets.
- Keep the watch away from strong magnetic fields, severe shock, and prolonged extreme temperatures.
- Wipe the case and crystal with a soft dry microfiber cloth after wear.
- Leather and suede straps should be kept as dry as possible; allow them to air dry naturally if damp.
- Rubber and stainless bracelets may be wiped down after sweat or water exposure, then dried thoroughly.
- Water resistance is not permanent and can be affected by impact, age, gasket wear, and crown position.
- Never operate the crown, chronograph pushers, or calendar correctors while the watch is wet or underwater.

## Water-Resistance Notes

Listed water resistance: 10 ATM. Water resistance ratings describe controlled test conditions, not a permanent guarantee against water entry. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in or screwed down, if applicable, before exposure to moisture.
